EDUCATION

10,691 youth showed improved growth in social, emotional and cognitive skills required to succeed

1,445 youth graduated from high school in four years

8,205 youth improved their standardized assessment scores

5,938 youth enrolled in post secondary education

8,507 youth advanced academically to the next grade level

21,233 youth engaged in volunteer or other nonacademic activities

20,977 elementary students prepared for middle school, and middle school students prepared for high school

12,461 youth gained knowledge and skills within structured out-of-school programming
