United Way of Greater Knoxville invested \$1,250,581 in 25 Financial Stability programs and partnered with 17 service providers to help individuals progress on their paths to financial stability.

FINANCIAL STABILITY

1,917 individuals in Knox County were able to access affordable services including, but not limited to legal, mental health, substance abuse, and reliable transportation services

247 individuals in Knox County found and maintained employment by receiving case management and/or employment counseling

814 individuals in Knox County advanced their level of employment through training and/or education

205 individuals in Knox County increased their capacity of consumer education including budgeting and credit counseling

21,347 families in Knox County received needed assistance for such support as clothing, rent, utilities, and transportation allowing their living conditions to stabilize

1,347 individuals in Knox County were able to maintain housing with support

244 families in Knox County were able to maintain housing after receiving housing counseling

127 families received homeownership counseling or foreclosure counseling were able to either secure a mortgage or restore their on-time payment status
